## **ANNEX 1 - MANDATORY CONDITIONS**

### **Door Supervision**

Where this Premises Licence includes a condition that one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, those individuals who are present to guard against a, b or c must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority:

- a. Unauthorised access or occupation (eg through door supervision)
- b. Outbreaks of disorder
- c. Damage

### **Supply of Alcohol**

Where this Licence authorises the supply of alcohol:

No supply of alcohol may be made under this licence:

- a. At a time when there is no Designated Premises Supervisor in respect of it
- b. At a time when the Designated Premises Supervisor does not hold a Personal Licence or his Personal Licence is suspended"

Every retail sale or supply of alcohol made under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a Personal Licence.

### **Exhibition of Films**

Where this Licence authorises the exhibition of films:

The admission of children under the age of 18 to film exhibitions permitted under the terms of this licence shall be restricted in accordance with any recommendations made:

- a. By the British Board of Film Classification (BBFC,) where the film has been classified by that Board
- b. By the Licensing Authority where no classification certificate has been granted by the BBFC or, where the Licensing Authority has notified the licence holder that section 20 (3) (b) (74 (3) (b) for clubs) of the Licensing Act 2003 applies to the film.

## **ANNEX 2A - CONVERTED CONDITIONS**

The restrictions relating to the permitted hours for the sale and supply of alcohol do not prohibit:

- a. Consumption of the alcohol on the premises by, or the taking, sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises.
- b. The ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered.
- c. The sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club.
- d. The sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces.
- e. The taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there.
- f. The supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied.
- g. The supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.
- h. Alcohol shall not be sold or supplied for consumption off the premises except in a sealed container.

## **ANNEX 2B - OPERATING SCHEDULE**

### **PREVENTION PUBLIC NUISANCE**

- Notices are to be prominently displayed at all exits from the premises requesting that patrons respect the needs of people living in the area and to leave the area quietly.
- When regulated entertainment is being provided the licence holder is to ensure that noise from the premises is monitored outside of the premises on at least three occasions. Where noise is found to be at a level likely to cause disturbance to people living in the vicinity, immediate steps are to be taken to reduce the noise level.

### **PUBLIC SAFETY**

- Fire Fighting equipment, emergency lighting and means of escape in case of fire as detailed in the plan at Annex 4, shall be provided and maintained at all times.

#### PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM

- There shall be no unaccompanied children on the premises.
- No children under the age of 16 are permitted after 21.00 hours.
- There shall be no gaming machines on the premises.

#### PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER

- The Premises shall register as a member of the Pubwatch Scheme in the locality and a representative of the Management Team shall attend all meeting.

#### ANNEX 3 - HEARING

- There shall be no music whatsoever in the outdoor areas indicated on Annex 4
- The outside areas, as indicated on the plan at annex 4, shall close at 23.00 hours Monday to Saturday and 22.30 hours on Sunday.
- Live music is limited to 12 times per year and shall comprise of not more than 2 performers.
