**Subject: Premises Licence – The Sutton Benger Extravaganza**

With regard to the above application for a premises license, I would like to make the following Representation.

The Application for the event does not include adequate measures that would be undertaken by the applicant to prevent Public Nuisance.

Last year the following conditions to include a noise level for the event were placed on the licence and no complaints of excess noise were received from residents of Sutton Benger.

- a. Amplifiers and any other noise generating equipment shall be configured and positioned so as to ensure that the noise shall not exceed Leq65dB(A) in any 15 minute period during the event, when measured free-field in any nearby residential outdoor living area.
- b. During the carrying out of licensable activities, a competent person shall carry out monitoring in the vicinity of any nearby properties, on at least three occasions, between the commencement and end of entertainment to demonstrate compliance with the above criteria.
- c. If the monitoring proves a noise level above the level given in condition 'a' then the volume of the music shall be reduced so that it conforms to condition 'a'.
- d. A record of such monitoring shall be kept in a book detailing the time, location and duration of any monitoring, along with any remedial action that may have been taken.
- e. At least a week before the event, residents likely to be affected by the event shall be informed that the event is to occur, and shall be provided with start and finish times for the entertainment. A mobile contact number shall be given to the residents so that they may report any disturbance to the premises supervisor

The Applicant is aware that the measures to prevent public nuisance provided in the application are not sufficient. I have provided the applicant with the above measures and understand that he would be willing to adhere to them during the event, and would accept them as conditions on the license.
