

Article 8 – Committees of the Council

8. Committees of the Council

- 8.01 Part 3 of this Constitution contains a section entitled Responsibility for Functions containing three tables headed Responsibility for Local Choice Functions, Responsibility for Council Functions and Responsibility for Shared Functions.
- 8.02 The Council will appoint the Committees set out in the right hand column of those tables in order to discharge the functions set out in their left hand column.
- 8.03 In summary, the Council will delegate:-
- (a) its planning functions to one or more Development Control Committees.
 - (b) its personnel, licensing, registration, administrative and health and safety matters to a Personnel Licensing and Administration Committee.
 - (c) Appointment of staff to an Appointments Committee.
 - (d) Appeals, grievances and disciplinary matters to an Appeals Committee.
- 8.04 The Council will also appoint a Standards Committee in accordance with Section 53 of the Local Government Act 2000 and a Licensing Committee in accordance with Section 6 of the Licensing Act 2003.
- 8.05 A member of the Executive shall not be the Chairman or Vice-Chairman of any of the Council's Committees, with the exception of Area Committees.
