

CORSHAM CYCLE/WALKING ROUTES



This map shows convenient routes for cycling and walking through Corsham linking residential areas to the Town Centre and facilities such as schools and places of work. It also shows walking and cycling links to other destinations further afield via the North Wiltshire District Cycle Network. There are also Cycle/ Walking maps for Chippenham, with Malmesbury on the reverse, and Wootton Bassett, with Cricklade on the reverse. The Cycle/ Walking map for Calne is on the reverse of this map.

There is a separate map available showing the North Wiltshire Rivers Route, and on the reverse a map of the North Wiltshire Cycle Network. The routes are sign posted both through the towns and the District. All of the maps are available free from Tourist Information Centres and Council Offices.

The routes shown are advised as the most direct and convenient, with least conflict with traffic. These are not the only routes for walkers and cyclists: all of the streets and roads shown on the map are able to be walked or cycled upon, and should be safe as the most fall within the 30 MPH limit.

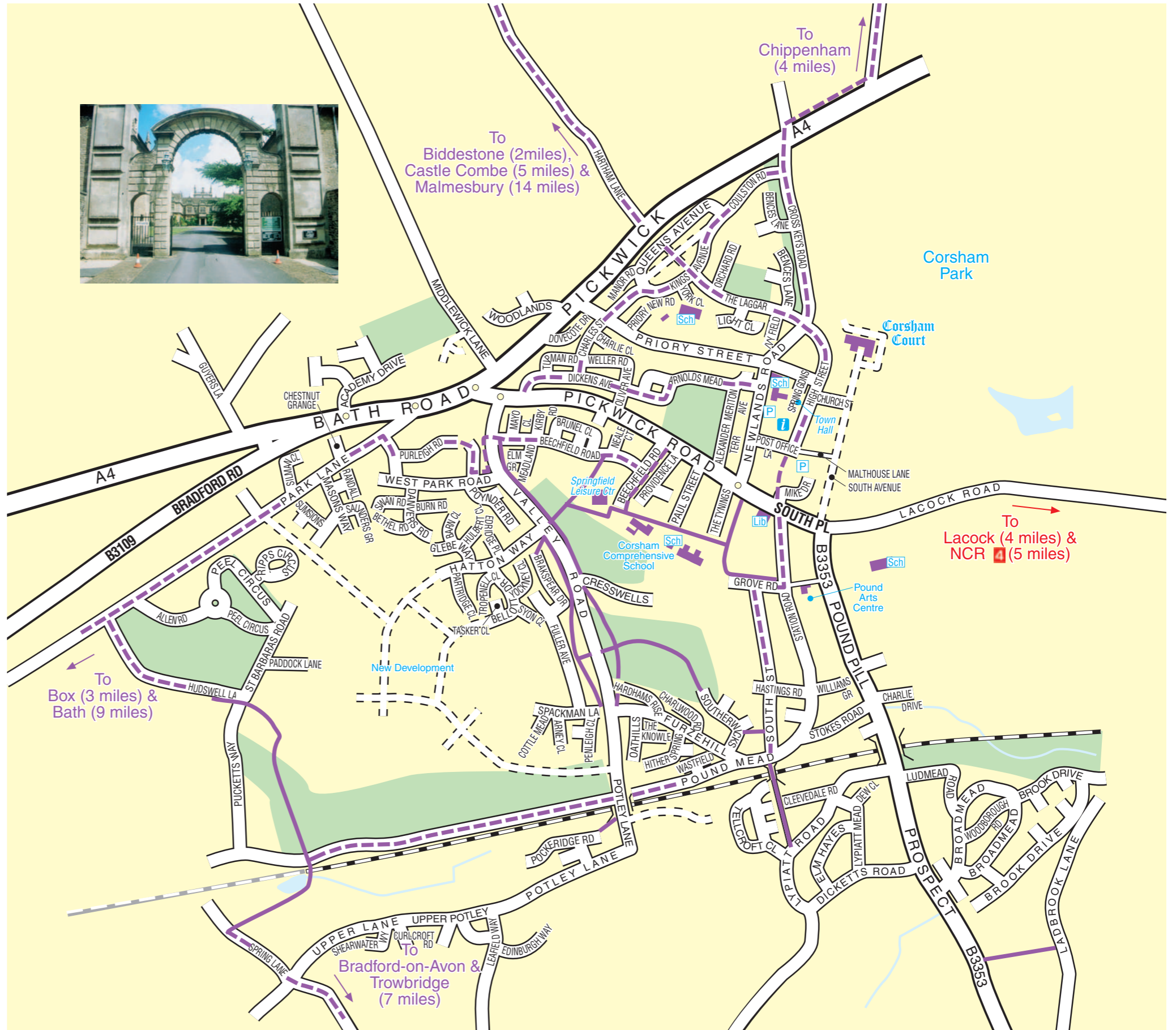


Parts of the network currently have 'no cycling' restrictions where riding a bicycle is an offence. However, you may push your bicycle along these sections to access the remaining network. Please only cycle on paths where they are signed for cycling or shared use.
